STRUCTURE OF DAILY LESSONS

Synchronous (first 30-35 minutes of class) - live virtual learning with teacher and other classmates during "realtime." This includes live-streaming lectures, video conferencing, teleconferencing, and live chatting.

Asynchronous (25-30 minutes each class) - When learners participate in learning absent from the teacher. It includes the following methods: self-guided lesson modules, exchanges across discussion boards or social media platforms, streaming video content, reviewing virtual libraries and posted lecture notes.

Independent Practice (this is asynchronous) - This work session can include re-teaching individual or small groups of students, independent reading or writing time, English Language support, and/or working on IEP goals and objectives.

Closing (last 10 minutes of class) - "live" virtual closing of the day's lesson with the teacher

Classes may vary by grade level
